

Garda Vetting

The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Act 2012 is due to be commenced by the Minister for Justice and Equality shortly. Under the new act it will be illegal for any individual to put themselves forward to work with children before successfully completing the Garda Vetting Bureau process.

All those who are involved with teams (juvenile and adult), referees, officers of committees that oversee underage activities and any other person who regularly provides a service to underage teams or children in our club must be Garda cleared.
